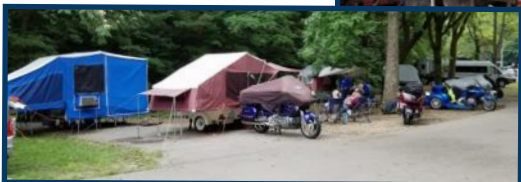

RIDER EDUCATION

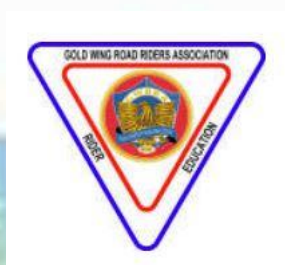
