

  - The Schoolhouse Restaurant is housed in a Civil War era building circa 1863. It was a two-room schoolhouse with one room now used as the kitchen and the other classroom is now a dining room. The windows, the yellow oak floors, and blackboards are from the late 1800's. Large round tables with built in lazy Susans can seat up to 8 people.
  - The menu is handwritten on the blackboard which you read as your salads are served to your table; a homemade creamy Cole slaw and tossed salad with our grandmother's sweet French salad dressing
  - Everyone orders their own entree which is served with fluffy mashed potatoes, gravy, two vegetables, and freshly made sweet cornbread.
  - We are famous for our Fried Chicken, half a fresh chicken, hand breaded, and fried to a golden brown. Other entrees include Chicken Livers, Country Fried Steak, Meatloaf, Roast Beef, Ham, BBQ Ribs, Baked Cod and Parmesan Salmon to name a few.
