The Dairy Isle became the place to be for the community. First dates, first kisses and first ice cream cones are among the many memories created at the Dairy Isle. In the 1970s she was the turn around point for muscle cars cruising up and down SR 125. The Dairy Isle has seen many owners and each owner has added to her history. Decades later, after many name changes, the community still calls her 'The Old Dairy Isle".
