As usual, in February Mileage and Attendance Awards for the previous year were announced and presented to those who were in attendance.

There were a total of 111 Events in 2025. Jack Redd won first place by participating in 61 Events. Kim Pommier attended 58 events for second place while Ron Harper attended 54 events for third place.

Five of the six members who were in the inaugural class of 10K Riders repeated for the second class.

- Andrew Cohen rode 18,513 miles
- Rick Cridlin, 18,036 miles
- Stephen Poat, 14,505 miles
- Randy Pommier, 10,679 miles
- and Kim Pommier, 10,501 miles

Leading the way for the remaining riders was:

- Rick Artmayer with 6,586 miles
- followed closely by Jeff Hinkle with 6,372 miles
- Charles Hobbs finished the group with 5,132 miles.

The average miles for the group minus the 10K group was 3,430. John Keiter was closest to the average with 3,817 Miles.

The total miles for all participants was 127,119 miles. Steve Holder won the SWAG award with a guess of 125,000.

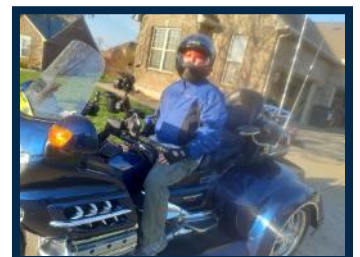
MEMBERSHIP ENHANCEMENT

The early classes fill up fast; it is best not to wait so you can get the dates that best fit your schedule. Because of publishing deadlines, I was unable to see many schedules but here are some companies and locations to check out if this is the year you decide to invest in your safety.

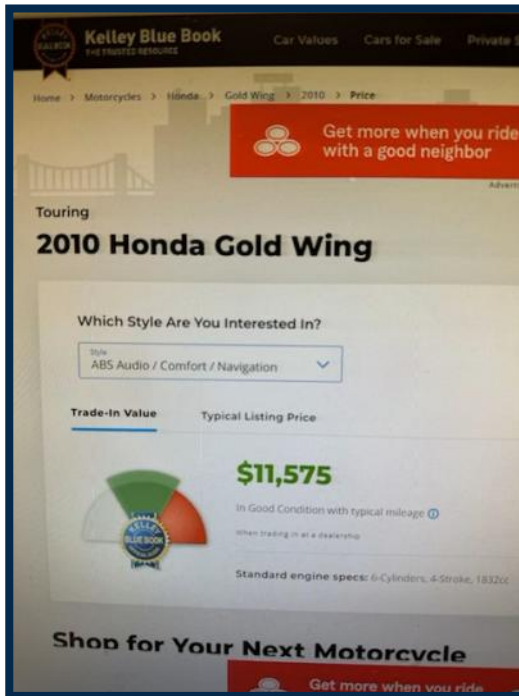

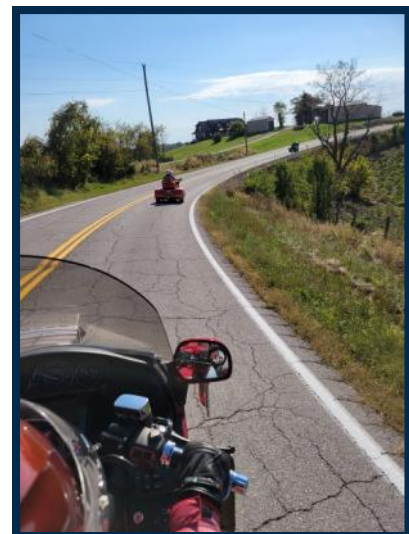
